

Mahindra Breaks through Fleet business in Chile



Mahindra Chile got a fleet business of 62 units (34 units of 4x4 and 32 units of 4x2) in November from CTR, a rural telephone company. They operate through Leasing Corporation, who has provided them service for more than 10 years, and always operated with Japanese origin vehicles.

CTR was a Canadian company that some year's ago passed into the hands of Chilean business partner. It is most important company in Chilean Rural Telephony (places without mobile signal). The Mahindra Pickup will be used for the maintenance of the antennas located in extreme places of the country, especially in South of Chile.
